March Presentation Topic: DOE New 2020 Pump Energy Standards

Topic: Centrifugal pump efficiency continues to be the focus in the world of hydronic heating and cooling systems. We will tell you what need to know now about the Dept. of Energy Conservation Standards for Pumps, which takes effect in January of 2020. Design engineers need to know how this affects them and their specifications. Also covered is the Hydraulic Institute Centrifugal Pump Energy Rating Program and what pump manufacturers are doing to get in compliance.
